The Anglican Sisters of Saint Margaret have run this home for over 100 years. It is a haven of peace at the junction of two of the busiest commuter roads in West London. St Mary's provides the homely environment of an extended Christian family and high quality care.



We have daily services in the Chapel, which all are welcome to; a special area is reserved for those in wheelchairs. The Chapel is always open for quiet reflection. Members of the local clergy come to celebrate the Eucharist each day and are available if residents, their family or friends wish to see them.



Physiotherapy and hairdressing are available each week. A chiropodist visits regularly and a doctor comes weekly to see residents registered with the local practice. Residents may transfer to this practice or stay with their own doctor. An optician visits periodically for annual eye checks. We offer a complete laundry service.

Very much a community, St Mary's is run in a way that makes people feel at home. We have our own minibus for outings and there are regular weekly activities including arts and crafts, board games, indoor bowls, reading groups, music and movement and sherry parties.





There are a variety of comfortable relaxing communal areas throughout the Home that anyone can use. These offer televisions (with DVD and video players), music centre, DVD, videos, music tapes, books and magazines.



The garden plays a big part in the lives of the residents. Many outside activities take place there including afternoon tea, BBQs, entertainment and games. There are pathways for wheelchairs, outdoor seating and all area welcome to help with the gardening, if they wish.



St Mary's has a number of comfortable dining rooms. Residents have a choice of meals and the menu is changed daily.



Fully trained nursing staff and carers are available day and night. Each resident has their own key worker. All residents are treated as individuals living in their own home; their comments are welcomed. Individual care plans are developed and maintained in conjunction with each resident and their family.

Much of the living accommodation is new and all the rest has been modernised to meet European standards. Single rooms are provided for the residents, with the option of using a few as double rooms for couples who wish to share. Some have low windows so the garden can be enjoyed, even when in bed.



All rooms have en-suite facilities. Some bedrooms have patio doors leading to the garden. Call bells, television aerials and telephone points are provided in each room, and an information pack.



Family and friends can visit us at any time (after 5:30pm please ring the night bell for access). Family members and friends are encouraged to get involved in their loved one's care and to be part of our life. Reflecting our place in the local community are the many volunteers who support our activities.



We are always seeking ways to improve our facilities and services. Recent major projects have included building five new bungalow homes for independent living with available care. These bungalows were opened in 2015 by HRH Princess Alexandra.
